RV Permit Guide

"When can you have an RV in the County?"

1. To be used for Temporary, Vacation or Recreational use. *

2. To use as a temporary dwelling while building a new residential dwelling. *

* Where applicable per Zoning Ordinances

Please see below for reference to the OSFM NC DOI clarifications for labeling & setting up of "Recreational Park Trailers" (formerly "Park Model" recreational vehicles)" (print out available upon request)

General Requirements per Article 552.4, NEC

A park trailer as specified in 552.2 is intended for seasonal use. It is not intended as a permanent dwelling unit or for commercial uses such as banks, clinics, offices, or similar.

Polk County Requirements for Temporary RV Use:

1. Zoning approval:

a. in some areas of the county, you may or may not be able to use an RV for any purpose; in some areas you can only store an RV on your property; once you have zoning preliminary or verbal approval you may move on to **Step #2.**

2. Environmental Health approval in the form of:

- a. New well and new septic OPERATIONS permits:
 - i. systems in the ground and ready for power for operation.
- b. Existing systems checks
 - i. If there is an existing system; the Environmental Health department can do an existing system check to verify the system can withstand RV hook-ups for temporary use.
 - ii. Once you have approval from EH you may proceed to Step #3.

3. RV permit from Building Inspections:

- a. Please fill out the Miscellaneous Permit Application
 - i. Please include: NC licensed: electrician & plumber

- ii. \$100.00 Permit fee (plus any Zoning Fees)
- b. Once permit is issued:
 - i. Your Electrician & Plumber Must call in for final inspections
 - ii. The Inspector will come out an inspect electrical and plumbing *ONLY*;
 - iii. Once you pass inspection, we will send off approval to the electrical company.

Things of note:

- You will not get an address with an RV permit; you must speak with the addressing department located in the Tax and Tag office about applying for a variance to our addressing ordinance for an address
